In exercise of the powers conferred under **Clause 12 (Saving and Interpretation Clause)** of the *CNLC Examinations (For Fair, Transparent & Efficient Conduction) Rules, 2025*, read with **Regulations Governing the Three-Year Bachelor Degree in Law (LL.B) with Semester System of Examination for Choice Based Credit System (Amended) 2025** and **REGULATIONS CUM SYLLABUS FOR TWO YEARS LL.M. DEGREE PROGRAM (CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM)**, to ensure clear and consistent evaluation, the following provisions are incorporated into these Rules effective immediately upon the passing of the resolution and the Board of Examination's recommendation, subject to post-facto ratification by the appropriate statutory body of the College.

1. Grading Scale

A. For LL.B. (3-Year) Degree Programme

Minimum Passing Criteria (LL.B.)

a.) No candidate shall be declared to have passed the LL.B. examination unless he/she secures:

- Minimum **36% marks in each theory paper**, and
- Minimum **45% marks in the aggregate** (theory and practical together), in each semester examination separately.

Provided that, if a candidate secures at least 36 % marks in each paper but fails to obtain 45% marks in the aggregate, he/she may be permitted to reappear in **any five papers** in order to achieve the required 45% aggregate.

aa.) If a candidate fails to appear in one or more papers or fails to secure the minimum passing marks in any individual paper or in the aggregate, **internal assessment marks shall be carried forward** to the subsequent examination.

2. Promotion Rules¹

First Semester Course & Examination: The candidates who have taken admission in LL.B. programme First Semester in a session will automatically be promoted to next semester provided that he/she has appeared in any of the paper.

Promotion to III-Semester: All students who have cleared 60% of the all the paper combining Semester I & II shall be promoted to Semester III, **Part II**.

Promotion to IV-Semester: The candidates who have taken admission in LL.B. programme, third Semester in a session will automatically be promoted to next semester provided that he/she has appeared in any of the paper.

Promotion to VI-Semester: The candidates who have taken admission in L.L.B. programme fifth Semester in a session will automatically be promoted to VIth semester provided that he/she has appeared in any of the paper.
