# THE REGULATIONS FOR TWO YEARS LL.M. DEGREE PROGRAM (CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM) AMENDMENT 2025

An Act to amend the Regulations for the Two-Year LL.M. Degree Program (Choice Based Credit System) at Chotanagpur Law College, Ranchi, with respect to the conduct of special examinations and resolution of regulatory difficulties.

#### **Preamble**

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the conduct of special examinations for final-year students and to incorporate a mechanism for resolving difficulties in the implementation of the LL.M. regulations;

Be it enacted by the Academic Council of Chotanagpur Law College, Ranchi, in exercise of its statutory powers, as follows:

### 1. Short Title and Commencement

- (i) This Act may be called "THE REGULATIONS FOR TWO YEARS LL.M.

  DEGREE PROGRAM (CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM) AMENDMENT
  2025."
- (ii) It shall come into force with effect from the academic year 2025–26.

## 2. Amendment of Regulation: Insertion of Section 14

After the existing provisions of the Regulations for the Two-Year LL.M. Degree Program (CBCS), the following sections shall be inserted:

#### Section 14: Special Examination for Final-Year Students

- (i) Final-year LL.M. students shall be permitted to appear for a special examination to clear academic backlogs in a maximum of four subjects.
- (ii) The special examination shall be conducted subsequent to the declaration of results for the Even Semester examinations.
- (iii) Applications for the special examination must be submitted to the Controller of Examinations within fifteen (15) days from the date of result declaration, accompanied by the prescribed examination fee.
- (iv) The syllabus and examination format for the special examination shall be identical to that of the regular examination for the respective subjects.

#### 3. Amendment of Regulation: Insertion of Section 15

Following Section 14, the following section shall be inserted:

## Section 15: Removal of Difficulty

- (i) In the event of any difficulty arising in the interpretation or implementation of these regulations, the decision of the Controller of Examinations shall be final and binding.
- (ii) All such decisions shall be subject to post facto ratification by the appropriate statutory body of the College.
- (iii) The Controller of Examinations shall ensure that all decisions are guided by the principles of fairness, transparency, and academic integrity.

## 4. Applicability

This Amendment Act shall apply to all final-year students enrolled in the LL.M. Degree Program under the Choice Based Credit System from the academic year 2025–26 onwards.
